

Personal Use Only Recreation Permit Rules and Regulations (This is not a Permit)

No Camp Fire, No Open Flame or burning of anything

No Motorized Vehicle Off-Road Activities

No Hunting

Must follow Principles of leave-No-Trace

Permit Holder will Pay any Additional Costs SNAI may accrue for Additional Clean-Up.

Permit Stipulation:

1. **Site Disturbance.** Use least amount of amount of ground necessary to protect local habitats. Particular attention must be paid to prevent pollution of streams, lakes, ponds, seeps and marshes, and to prevent disturbances to fish and wildlife populations and habitats.
2. **Solid Waste.** All solid waste, debris and hazardous substances generated from short-term (portable) camp use or other activities conducted in accordance with this authorization shall be removed from SNAI land. Trails and campsites must be kept clean and safe; Waste from pets or horses must be disposed of at least 200 ft from any water source, camp site and trails. Burial of trash is prohibited.
3. **Timber Use.** No Fires or burning of anything, no timber use.
4. **Greywater and Human Waste Disposal.** All greywater, and human or pet waste must be disposed of in a 6"-8" deep cathole. Cathole must be located at least 200 feet from the ordinary high water mark of the nearest waterbody, and back-filled prior to leaving.
5. **Fuel Storage.** The total combined fuel stored campsite shall not exceed ½ gallon. All containers must be clearly marked with the contents and the permittee's name. The permittee is responsible for preventing spillage and contamination of contiguous land and water as well as cleaning up any pollutants that result from activities associated with this permit.
6. **Removal of Personal Property.** All components of camps, personal property (e.g. camp gear, containers, pets & trash etc.), hazardous substances and solid waste must be removed from SNAI land on or before the end of the authorized term of use. Permittee shall not remove any vegetation or materials.
7. **Operation of Vehicles.** Off road vehicular travel is NOT permitted.
8. **Duty to Avoid.** Must stay clear of any heavy equipment, construction/ resource extraction operations /sites.
9. **Inspections.** All camps on SNAI-owned land are subject to inspection by SNAI personnel at any time.
10. **Fire Prevention, Protection and Liability.** DO NOT build fires! The permittee & group shall take all reasonable precautions to prevent and suppress fires, and shall assume full liability for any damages to SNAI land resulting from negligent use of fire. SNAI is not liable for damage to the permittee's personal property and is not responsible for forest fire protection of the permittee's activity.
11. **Compliance with Requirements.** The permittee shall inform and ensure that all members of group will comply with all applicable laws, regulations, rules and the stipulations included in this authorization.
12. **Indemnification.** Permittee assumes all responsibility, risk and liability for all activities of the permittee and group members directly or indirectly conducted in conjunction with this permit. Permittee shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless SNAI, its employees and agents from and against any and all suits, claims, actions, losses, costs, penalties and damages of whatever kind of nature including all attorney fees and litigation costs, arising out of, in connection with or incident to any act of omission by permittee and group members.
13. **Valid Existing Rights.** This authorization is subject to all valid existing rights in and to the land covered under this authorization. SNAI makes no representations or warranties, whatsoever either expressed or implied, as to the existence, number of nature of such valid existing rights.
14. **Termination.** This permit **is not a property right**. It is a temporary authorization, revocable by SNAI with or without cause.
15. **Preference Right.** No preference right for long term use or conveyance of the land is granted or implied by the issuance of this permit.
16. **Assignment.** This permit is not transferable and authorizes specific activities requested by the permittee.

- 17. **Other Authorizations.** This permit does not eliminate the need to obtain other necessary authorizations from federal, state and local agencies and affected private entities.
- 18. **Amendments.** The permittee must have the prior written approval of SNAI to use short-term portable camps in areas other than those specified in this authorization.
- 19. **Permit Use.** Hike, Bike, Berry Pick, Sport Fish, Temporary No-Impact Camp.
